



COURSE OUTCOME – FORENSIC MEDICINE & TOXICOLOGY

At the end of the course, the student will be able to:

- 1) Appear in a Court of law as an expert witness and give evidence in cases of medico legal purview.
- 2) Practice medicine in the society following medical ethics and etiquette as prescribed by the Medical Council of India.
- 3) Able to independently conduct autopsy on medico-legal cases and issue postmortem certificates.
- 4) To examine cases of clinical forensic medicine and issue required medico-legal certificates.
- 5) To treat cases of poisoning and issue certificates to the court and the police.
- 6) Identify the basic medico legal aspects of hospital and general practice.
- 7) Define the medico legal responsibilities of a RMP while rendering community service either in a primary or tertiary setting.
- 8) Diagnose, manage and identify also legal aspects of common acute and chronic poisonings and preserve requisite samples for investigative agencies.
- 9) Describe the medico legal aspects and findings of post-mortem examination in case of unnatural death.
- 10) Detect occupational and environmental poisoning and advise on its prevention and document epidemiology.

11) Make observations and logical inferences in order to initiate enquiries in criminal matters and medico legal problems.

12) Diagnose and treat common emergencies in poisoning.
